Care and Cleaning

FABRIC	CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS
Clarity 1%, 3%, 5%, 10%* Dawn 3%, 5%* Flare 3%, 5%* Radiance 14%* Stanton 6% T Screen 3%, 5%	Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or any abrasive substances which might damage the coating of the fabric. Clean with a sponge or a soft brush dipped in soapy water using mild detergent. Rinse with clean water. Leave the blind down until completely dry. You can also very gently rub the fabric with a clean white pencil eraser to remove small stains.
Bleecker 6% Broome 0% (Blackout)	Wipe clean with warm soapy water and a damp cloth.
Fine Lines 30%* Lumen 15%	Light dusting with a feather duster is recommended. Spot cleaning may be done with mild detergent. Pretest a small inconspicuous area before proceeding with spot cleaning. Do not saturate–this may cause noticeable spotting.
Franklin 19% Majesty 12%	Regular light dusting with a feather duster is suggested. A hand-held vacuum with low suction may also be used. When vacuuming, avoid pulling or stretching the fabric. Rigorous vacuuming is not recommended since this could distort the fabric. Alternatively, dirt and debris can be blown away using compressed air or a hand-held hair dryer on the cool setting. Spots can be cleaned gently blotting with a soft, damp cloth or sponge, using lukewarm water and a mild detergent. Be careful not to apply too much pressure to the fabric. Let air dry.
Lucca 0% (Blackout) Roscoe 0% (Blackout)	Clean with mild soap and water. If cleaners other than mild soap and water are desired, test in an inconspicuous area prior to use. Disinfectants containing bleach may be used. Avoid cleaners containing quaternary ammonium compounds and phenols. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning. Paint solvents should not be used.
Dusk 0% (Blackout)	Remove dust with vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or any abrasive substance which might damage the coating of the fabric. The front side of Dusk is treated with DURAGUARD® Fabric Protector and can therefore be spot cleaned by gently blotting with a sponge or soft brush dipped in lukewarm soapy water using a mild detergent. The foam coating on the back side should not get wet. A dry chemical sponge or clean white pencil eraser can be used to remove small stains.
GreenScreen Revive 1%, 5%	Regular light dusting with a feather duster is suggested. A hand-held vacuum with low suction may also be used. When vacuuming, avoid pulling or stretching the fabric. Rigorous vacuuming is not recommended since this could distort the fabric. Alternatively, dirt and debris can be blown away using compressed air or a hand-held hair dryer on the cool setting.
Panache 3%	Remove dust with a light brush. Lay screen down on flat surface before cleaning and do not apply pressure. Blot up as much of the spill as possible with a soft and slightly wet, clean white sponge. Do not rub. Do not use spot cleaners containing bleach or alcohol. Do not use dry clean or machine wash screen. For best results, use pure cleaning solvents or water based cleaning products.
Striate 0% (Blackout)	Fabric is recommended to be regularly dusted and cleaned with a dry cloth.

Clarity 1%, 3%, 5%, 10% Dawn 3%, 5% Flare 3%, 5% Radiance 14%	Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or any abrasive substances which might damage the coating of the fabric.
Fine Lines 30%	Light dusting with a feather duster is recommended.
Tuscany 0% (Blackout)	Fabric should be regularly dusted/vacuumed as appropriate.
