

## Care and Cleaning

GENERAL MAINTENANCE - All chain can be dry-dusted as necessary.

| Finish and Base               | Routine Cleaning   | DO NOT USE   |

| Aluminum                      | Use a pH-neutral soap with warm water applied with a sponge or cloth, followed by a clean water rinse. Stubborn stains may require the use of a light duty cleaning pad or a specialty aluminum cleaner. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use strong bleaches or chloride based cleaners. This may cause oxidation and make the material turn dark. |
| Antique Brown (Brass)         | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use liquid cleaners or chemicals.   |
| Brass Plated Steel            | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use liquid cleaners or chemicals. Should not be located near steam or liquid.                             |
| Custom Color (Carbon Steel)   | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use liquid cleaners or chemicals. Should not be located near steam or liquid.                             |

| Nickel Plated Steel           | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use liquid cleaners or chemicals. Should not be located near steam or liquid.                             |
| Satin Steel (Carbon Steel)    | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use liquid cleaners or chemicals. Should not be located near steam or liquid.                             |
| Stainless Steel               | Use a pH-neutral soap with warm water applied with a sponge or cloth, followed by a clean water rinse. Stubborn stains may require the use of a light duty cleansing pad or specialty stainless steel cleaner. For fingerprints, an organic solvent such as acetone, alcohol, methylated, or spirits can be used. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry. Where stainless steel has become extremely dirty, a mild abrasive and a mild cleaning solution, such as Ajax, can be used. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry. | Do not use strong bleaches or chloride based cleaners.   |
| Yellow Brass                  | Dry-dust as necessary. Should further polishing be required, the chain can be buffed with a polishing cloth.   | Do not use for liquid cleaners or chemicals.   |
